- Footnotes should be limited to explanatory purpose and kept to minimum. Tables and figures should
 be placed according to the text and should be numbered separately and sequentially. Equations and
 formula should be written using equation editor and numbered at the right in parentheses.
- All references should be alphabetically arranged and APA style should be followed.
